The Ashleigh School community joins the Royal Family and the nation in mourning the loss of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II.

As sovereign to the UK and Commonwealth for more than 70 years, and as the longest-reigning British Monarch, she leaves behind an extraordinary legacy of service and dedication.

From a young girl who did not expect to be Queen, to an iconic and celebrated figure who became Britain's longest reigning monarch. For every generation, she provided an example and continuity that unites us today in offering our heartfelt condolences.

We have used today to remember and celebrate the life of Queen Elizabeth. After a special assembly in the morning, everyone observed a 2 minute silence at 11am. Children throughout school have had the opportunity to talk about how they feel about recent events.

We have set aside an area near to the Ashleigh sign in the gardens, where from tonight onwards, you can lay flowers. This will be available before and after school, all next week.

Although it wasn't appropriate to have our usual celebration assembly this morning, today's golden tie winners will have their ties presented next Friday.

We will share any other arrangements with you, as they become known to us.
